2. Employment: Within 6 months in office, over 8 Bende graduates have benefited from Federal employment.
3. Electricity: Ensured the restoration of electricity to Bende Town ending a 2-year period of darkness in Bende.
4. Education: Implemented several education support projects for ndi Bende including:
 - a. Sponsoring the education and training of five (5) blind Bende students at secondary and tertiary level.
 - b. Provided bursary for over 400 Bende students in various tertiary institutions.
 5. Skills Acquisition and Empowerment (Youth and Women): Collaborated with Project Development Institute (PRCDA) to implement skills acquisition training for several Bende Entrepreneurs, empowering them with tailoring machines, deep freezers, clippers and generating sets. Etc.
6. Security and Transport Support Programmes: Donation of 20 motorbikes to various wards in Bende to curb insecurity in Bende.
7. Bende Widow Support Programme (17th Edition)
8. Bende Food Support Programme (17th Edition)
9. Provision of Social Welfare/Assistance: Provided welfare/assistance, ranging from financial, social, educational, health and business to over 1500 indigees of Bende Federal Constituency since election as a Member of the House of Representatives, which includes the payment of hospital bills for over 60 persons in Bende Federal Constituency, and the sponsoring of a Bende constituent to India for tourism.
10. Establishment of a 200-Seater Capacity Constituency Office.
11. Upcoming Programmes/Projects: Plans to implement the following programmes/projects are underway:
 - a. Establishment of weekend school centres
 - b. Strengthening of Agricultural Cooperative Societies in Bende
 - c. Interactive session to strengthen post-election inter-party relationship
 - d. Health support programme for 4000-5000 eye patients in Bende

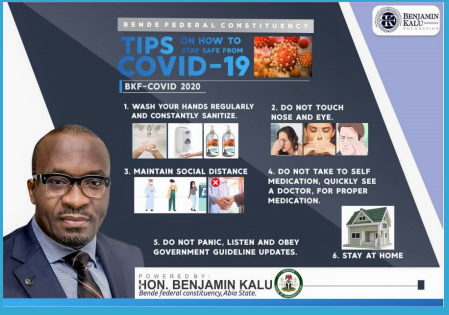
1. The Green Chamber Magazine: Ideated and introduced the Green Chamber Magazine, the official magazine publication of the House.
2. Bende Projects in the National 2020 Budget: Worked assiduously to ensure that the following projects were captured in the 2020 Appropriation Act for the good of Bende:
 - a. Renovation of a block of classroom in Nkpa, Uzuakoli, Umuhu, Bende LGA, Abia State
 - b. Construction of blocks of classrooms in Bende LGA, Abia State
 - c. Construction of primary health care centre in Nhalukuw, Imbuzo, Bende LGA, Abia State
 - d. Procurement/installation of 300kva transformer at Bende Federal Constituency, Abia State
 - e. Construction of 1km rural road with drainage and asphalt from Amosaku in Alayi Bende local government area of Abia State
 - f. Rehabilitation of Ohafia, Umusi and Onuhina erosion sites in Bende/Ohafia LGA of Abia State
 - g. Construction of 2km with drainage and asphalt from Umusohi Amankulu to Abilibo Ohafia road in Bende/Ohafia Local Government Area of Abia State
3. Rehabilitation of Bende - Imbuzo- Ekiulorood, Bende Federal Constituency
4. Rehabilitation of Bende - Archukuw - Ohafarood section 1/c/no.6481
 - a. Construction of motorized boreholes/deep well boreholes/hand pump borehole at Katsina Central, Etuko Central LGA, Ijigwe North West Senatorial District, Ikwere Bay, Ohafia Town Uruu, Akallimngi, Gidon Hilan Arkilo, Sakole, Akimorin, Afijio LGA - Oyo State
 - b. General maintenance of Umushia - Bende - Ohafia road route no.421 (f. 107) in Abia State
 - c. Rehabilitation/maintenance of roads and provision of solar street lights to some senatorial districts/federal constituencies.
5. Niger Delta Development Commission (NDDC): Attracted NDDC's inspection, intervention and repositioning of abandoned projects in Bende led by the Acting Managing Director Dr. Jai Nuriish NDDC has now commenced the rehabilitation of the Nhalukuw Health Centre.
6. Umushia-Bende-Ohafia Road: Vigorously represented the dilapidated state of the Umushia-Bende stretch of the Umushia-Bende-Ohafia road to the Federal Ministry of Works and Housing as a result of which FG has commenced work to rehabilitate the road.

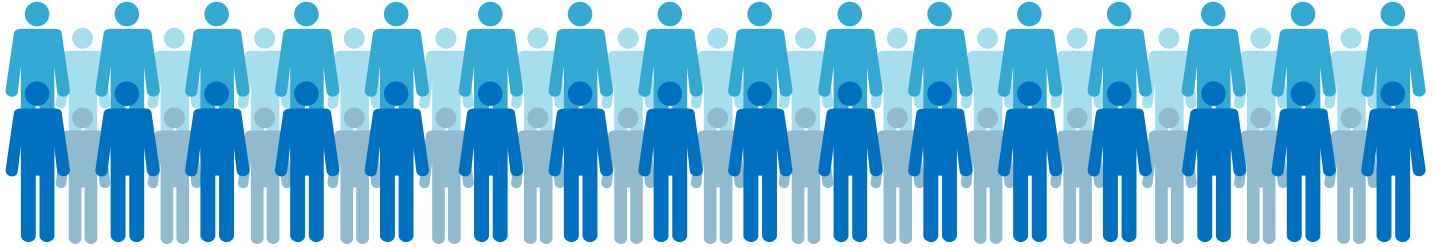

Covid-19 Interventions, Palliatives and Cash Transfers

The Covid-19 pandemic of 2020 and the resultant lockdown protocols quickly evolved beyond a global public health concern to an economic crisis of unprecedented proportions for mankind as a whole, but more immediately, for the indigenes of Bende Federal Constituency in Abia State.

In supporting the state and federal government efforts to combat the pandemic, the office of Rep. Benjamin Okezie Kalu implemented the following interventions:

A Deployed thousands of relief supplies and hygiene materials for distribution around all communities in the constituency; including face masks, hand sanitizers, hand gloves, washing soaps, thermometers and various food items.

B 150 bags of rice, 1000 cartons of indomie noodles, 1000 bottles of sanitizers, 5000 facemasks, 5000 pairs of hand gloves, and 5000 branded buckets with taps for hand washing, distributed to members of our Constituency, particularly the most vulnerable, to cushion the effects of the pandemic and check mate the spread.

C Sponsored the training of training of selected health workers from every ward by the emergency response team at Federal Medical Centre (FMC), on the World Health Organization (WHO) approved guidelines for preventing the spread of Coronavirus.

D Radio jingles, billboards, posters and other awareness materials were produced to educate ndi Bende on the necessary protocols to be observed in curbing the spread the Covid-19 pandemic.

E About 4550 persons were given palliative in every federal ward (350 per ward).

F About 4550 elderly people were attended to in every federal ward (350 per ward).
